VALE MATTHEW SPOHR (1975-2022)


All members of the NCRLRA & the entire league community mourn the loss of our friend and life member Matthew Spohr who passed away in June this year

Following on from 2 years of our competitions being impacted by the COVID epidemic, this year we have faced el-nina conditions, which has waterlogged many of our grounds for most of the year. This has resulted in mass cancellations, postponements, and changes to the structure of our competitions which has introduced lots of uncertainties week after week. In the face of these challenges, we have seen some magnificent resilience shown by all our members. This has been a highlight out of some pretty dark, dim and difficult times. Our members, over the past few years especially, have shown commitment, grit, determination and pure strength to meet the adversities that have been laid in front of us.

Being a match official in any sport is challenging at the best of times. Rugby League is no exception. - · Maintain interests away from refereeing.
- Understand when you are under stress and what to do to limit it.
- Build strong positive relationships with other members i.e. build each other up, don't pull each other down regardless of circumstance, beliefs or what happens with appointments
- Have a debrief system in place for your own relief and confirmation about your actions by speaking with the Director of Welfare and Support.

Thank you for a challenging but successful 2022 season. I look forward to 2023 and what it will bring.






